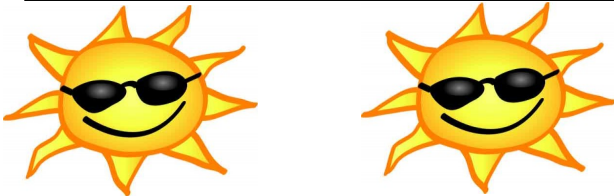
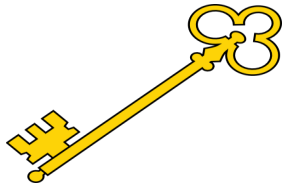
The Office will be closed Monday, August 10, 2020 to celebrate Victory Day.
