This Month's Recipe

Easy Apple Pie

This easy apple pie is a quintessential fall recipe that you can make with pre-made pie dough and basic ingredients- perfect for Thanksgiving.

Prep Time 10 minutes
Cook Time 50 minutes
Resting Time 1 hour
Total Time 2 hours



Ingredients

- 2 pastry dough pre-made (9-inches)
- 3 tablespoons <u>all-purpose flour</u>
- ½ cup granulated sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg
- 1/4 teaspoon <u>cinnamon</u>
- 6 apples seeded, sliced (sweet and tart varieties)
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- 1 large egg whisked

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 375°F with a baking tray.
- 2. In a large bowl, combine the sugar, lemon juice, and the apples, let stand for 15 minutes. In a second bowl combine flour, nutmeg, and cinnamon.
 - 3. Line a 9-inch pie plate with one of the pie dough, allowing it to droop over the edges slightly. Drain the sliced apples in a colander, add flour and spice mixture, toss to combine place the apple mixture into the bottom crust evenly.
- 4. Place the second pie dough over the apple mixture and gently press to ensure it is sitting well on top of the apples. Use a knife to cut a hole the size of a quarter in the center of the pie dough to allow the steam to escape. Trim and crimp the edges. Brush the top of the pie with the whisked egg.
